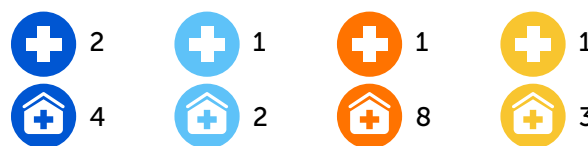




Enhanced Primary Care Plan

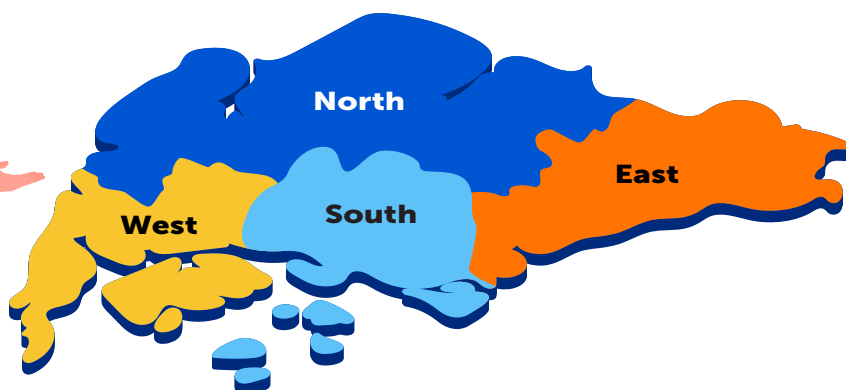
From 1 April 2027, the Enhanced Primary Care Plan (PCP) will bring healthcare closer to migrant workers while lowering or maintaining costs for almost all employers.

Most migrant workers will have access to a PCP clinic within 2km or where they live, compared to 3km today, under new Anchor Operators and geographical zones.



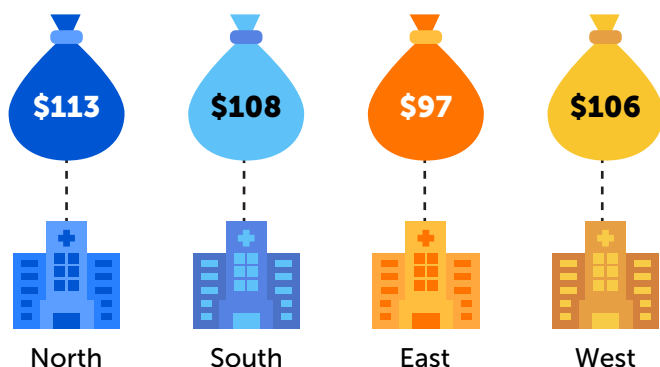

Almost all employers will pay the same or lower annual PCP capitation rates



A centralised PCP Enrolment Portal will be launched from 1 April 2027 to simplify administration for employers.

Migrant workers will continue to have affordable and convenient access to healthcare

- Co-payments for physical clinic consultations and telemedicine services will be affordable and standardised at \$5 per consultation
- Enhanced appointment booking systems to book, modify or cancel appointments in advance

Zonal Medical Centres serve as central hubs within each zone for the provision of primary healthcare services, including facilities and equipment for diagnostic imaging, basic surgical procedures and conveyance.



Partner Clinics may be an existing clinic operated by the Anchor Operator (AO), a clinic operator operated by a private General Practitioner in partnership with the AO, or a new clinic to be set up by the AO.
